Clinton Reopening Fast Facts

AM Schedule

8:00-10:40 (8:00 – 10:00 on Wednesdays)

PM Schedule

11:35-2:15 (11:25-1:25 on Wednesdays)

This is the same schedule for live instruction and for distance learning via Zoom.

Students will be let on campus starting 15 minutes before the start of school

Before coming to school

- Make sure to enter child health information via Parent Square
- Make sure that your child is not displaying any symptoms related to Covid
- Make sure your child has a mask and is wearing it properly

Temperature Checks

- Temperature checks will be taken prior to getting on the bus and entering Clinton
- TK and Kinder students will come to their gates by the playground
- 1st and 2nd grade students will enter by the gate next to the office
- 3rd and 4th grade will enter by the gate next to the MPR
- 5th and 6th will enter off of Clinton Avenue by the 200 wing. You will see the signs and the gate will be open.
- These gates will also be where the students will exit the school

Office Procedures and visitor policy

- No visitors are allowed on campus
- Only GGUSD staff can be on site
- The office staff will help with temperature checks; therefore, the office will be closed from 7:40-8:00 and again from 11:15-11:40. If you need to call the office, please leave a message and a staff member will call back in a timely manner.
- The office will be closed to visitors and we kindly request that you schedule an appointment for issues that cannot be addressed over the phone.

Mask and Social Distancing Policy

- As per Orange County Health Guidelines, all staff and students (regardless of grade level) have to wear a mask.
- Students will be provided masks if you do not have one for them
- A face shield will also be provided for all students
- Parents are asked to maintain social distancing to the greatest extent possible and must wear a mask at all times.
- Clinton staff will also work hard to maintain social distancing when working with students. The most challenging time will be at dismissal, therefore, masks are vital for safety during this time.

Lunches

- All students will be provided a grab and go lunch as they exit campus
- Students who remain on distance learning can continue to get Grab and Go lunches at Santiago High school
- No eating will occur on campus

Bussing

- Students will have their temperatures taken prior to boarding the bus
- Bus riders will enter campus through the MPR since they have already had their temperatures taken

Checked out Chrome Books, Hot Spots, and I-pads

- If you checked out a device from school, you can keep that at home since we have enough for students to use one in class.
- We will not collect the checked out devices until the end of the school year in June. The reason is this serves as a safeguard in case schools are ordered to close again so we can just continue with Distance learning without needing to redistribute items.
- Hot Spots will also not be collected until June.
